

# Dunkettle Progress Update





- Works are continuing across the site at all remaining structures and embankment construction – see photograph below.

- Ground improvement works at Link F alongside the N25 eastbound, which involve the installation of vertical drains are nearing completion. The last remaining area requiring this type of ground improvement will be progressed at the southern side of the N25 westbound from W/C 20/06/22 – see photograph below.

- The works associated with the construction of the Structure St08 Retaining Wall is now underway alongside the M8 northbound and the Cork to Midleton railway line – see photograph below.

- The first section of the new Retaining Wall RW05 under the existing bridge at the Dunkettle Interchange Roundabout was poured this week – see photograph below.
