

# Dunkettle Progress Update



- Motorists are again reminded that speed control measures and CCTV monitoring is in place on site with a particular focus at present


on the N40 westbound approach to the Jack Lynch Tunnel where the new traffic lights have been installed recently.

- Following on from the redirecting of traffic under Structure ST05, ground improvement works are being carried out at the western side of Structure St05. These works will move onto the carriageway itself over the coming period with a total of 20 piles to be installed under night time working on Monday 12th, Tuesday 13th and Wednesday 14th December 2022. Local diversions will be in place for traffic each night. The works are being completed at night in order to minimise the disruption to motorists – see photograph below.



Ground Improvement works ongoing on the footprint of the old N40 at the southern side of the Dunkettle interchange Roundabout.

- We still hope to place bridge beams on one further Structure, ST08 before Christmas. We are targeting the night of Tuesday 20th December 2022 for these works with localised traffic diversions in place to facilitate the works – see photograph below of the ongoing preparatory works for the same.




Preparatory works ongoing at Structure ST08 in advance of beam placement.

- Surfacing works in the median area of the N25 will continue until Friday 16th December 2022 – no traffic disruption is anticipated in relation to these works – see photograph below. The photograph also shows slip-forming of the new concrete median barrier being progressed.
